City of Arcata adopts energy efficiency reach code

The City of Arcata City Council unanimously approved an energy efficiency reach code for new residential construction as part of the community's long-term efforts to greatly reduce the climate change impact of energy use in Arcata.

The new code requires that new residential construction achieve specified percentages better than the Title 24 standard, 30% for single family and 20% for multi-family. As required by the CPUC, Arcata used an existing study that showed that the proposed Reach Code is cost effective.
