

Program started in 2007 as partnership between City of Palm Desert, Southern California Edison, Southern California Gas Company, and The Energy Coalition Designed as an aggressive and groundbreaking energy efficiency model Goals: - Reduce energy consumption within City by 30% over 5 years - 215 M kWh; (13,200 Homes/yr.) - 48.7 MW peak demand; and - 5.7 M Therms natural gas - Empower community to save energy, money, environment

One Stop Shop Results

- "One Stop Shop" Pool Pump/Heater Program:
 - During 2 year period 800 variable speed pool pumps installed
 - 100 EE Pool Heaters installed
- Partnership efforts have achieved carbon emissions savings of 36,407 metric tons of CO2
 - Equivalent of removing 7,900 autos from the road
