
San Francisco Bay Area Regional Energy Network (BayREN)

- 4/1/13 Joint IOU/REN Advice Letter EUC Implementation – Approved 5/31/13
- Approved Funding (\$26.6 million)
 - Single Family Retrofit: \$9 million
 - Multi-family Retrofit: \$7.3 million
 - Codes and Standards: \$3.4 million
 - Financing for EE Retrofits: \$6.9 million*
