Partner Accomplishments

Completed HVAC maintenance on 350 units under HVAC Optimization program in 2016. Expected to do another 150 units in 2016- 2017 fiscal year. These energy savings being attributed to HVAC Maint. Core Program, but county will realize savings of approximately 800,000 kWh since 2015.

County submitted applications for 3 EV Charge Ready Locations and these are being considered currently.
