


Advancing Energy Efficiency Goals

CALIFORNIA ENERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS

- California's highest priority energy procurement source.
- Traditionally administered by Investor Owned Utilities
- Lancaster began process of "Elect to Administer" Programs 2016
- Advice Letter 5-E filed with CPUC October 2017



FUNDING

- CPUC certified Lancaster's plan and approved 3-year budget
- Funded with non-bypassable charges collected from all rate payers
- CPUC handles oversight of Program
