



#### **Objective:**

To engage, expose and challenge students to explore architecture, engineering and construction careers by capitalizing on public works investment, community college STEAM course offerings and strong industry participation.

GRID Alternatives and Marin Community Foundation Solar installation training for disadvantaged communities




MCE and RichmondBUILD partnered to train and employ workers for the MCE Solar One project completed in 2018.
