

# 2021 Budget Act of California

The <u>California Climate and Energy Collaborative</u> (CCEC) exists to help local governments achieve their clean energy and climate goals. That's why we create our <u>annual legislative update</u> - to provide an easy-to-digest summary of the climate and energy bills that were passed into law in the 2021 California legislative cycle. The <u>Alliance of Regional Collaboratives for Climate</u> <u>Adaptation</u> (ARCCA) puts out a companion legislative update that focuses on adaptation policies. This supplemental, stand-alone update on California's Budget Act 2021 (SB 170) summarizes the energy-related appropriations.

### SB-170 Budget Act of California

#### **State Air Resources Board**

» \$971 million for clean fuel vehicles (Sec. 85 & 86)

### Office of Planning and Research

- \* \$115 million for the Transformative Climate Communities (TCC) program, to be expended by June 30, 2026 (Sec. 15)
- \* \$25 million for climate resilience and implementation grants to local, regional, and tribal governments through the Integrated Climate Adaptation and Resiliency Program (ICARP) (Sec. 16)
- \* \$10 million for Climate Adaptation and Resilience Planning Grants, to be expended by June 30, 2024 (Sec. 15)
- \* \$10 million for the Regional Climate Collaborative Program, to be expended by <u>June 30</u>, 2026 (Sec. 15)

## **California Energy Commission**

\* \$58 million for the Building Initiatives for Low-Emissions Development Program for buildings and appliances (Sec. 41)



#### **Department of Community Services and Development**

» \$38.6 million for the low income weatherization program (Sec. 107, 109, & 110)

#### Go-Biz

» \$31 million for the Climate Catalyst Fund Revolving Loan Fund (Sec. 6)

#### San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles Rivers and Mountains Conservancy

- » \$11 million for climate resilience and wildfire protection projects (Sec. 69)
- » \$10 million for climate resilience projects (Sec. 67)

### **Santa Monica Mountains Conservancy**

- » \$11 million for climate resilience and wildfire protection projects (Sec. 66)
- » \$10 million for climate resilience projects (Sec. 64)

- \* \$10 million for grants to CBO's and residents for emergency preparedness and environmental and climate decision-making (Sec. 13)
- \* \$5 million for the California Green Business Network, to help businesses reduce energy use and reduce their carbon footprint (Sec. 12)

» \$11 million for climate resilience (Sec. 73)
